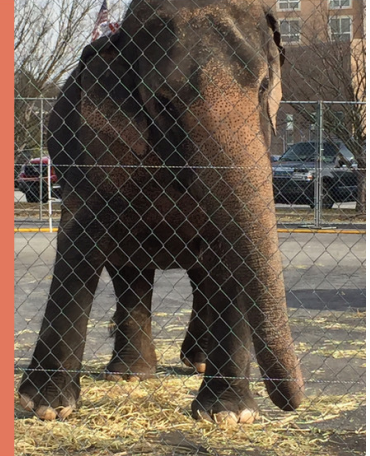


CWI INVESTIGATES

CIRCUS

At CWI, we monitor the numerous traveling circuses touring the country to seek out instances of **animal abuse** and neglect. We report violations of the Animal Welfare Act to the USDA, and use our findings to create educational videos to improve our community engagement efforts. Collectively our anti-animal circus videos have had **more than 500,000 views**.

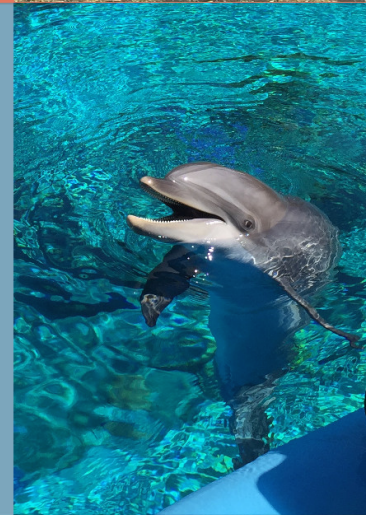
To date, we have monitored dozens of circus performances, including those by Ringling Bros, Cole Bros, Kelly Miller, UniverSoul, various Shrine Circuses, and smaller acts, with **over a dozen violations reported**.



MARINE MAMMALS

Despite widespread public disapproval of marine mammal cruelty, many entertainment facilities persist in holding dolphins, orcas, and other sentient beings captive for profit. We **monitor** facilities at SeaWorld Orlando, as well as the Dolphin Habitat at the Mirage in Las Vegas and use our findings and video to **empower advocates** in their efforts to combat marine mammal captivity.

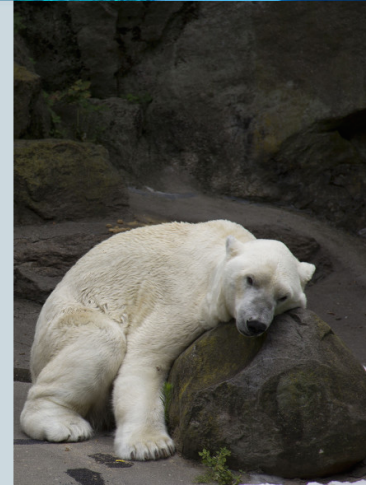
In 2015, CWI was part of a coalition that advocated against the building of a dolphinarium in Da Nang, Vietnam. We mounted a petition that has garnered nearly 5,000 signatures. Currently, due to international condemnation, the **Da Nang dolphinarium project is on hold**.



ZOOS

In 2016, CWI joined the fight to expose the truth about animal captivity in zoos. We helped bring exposure to the tragic death of **Harambe** via social media with posts that have shared our message that captivity is not conservation with more than **2.3 million people**.

Following, we have mounted several zoo investigations, including into the captivity of Tundra the polar bear by the Bronx Zoo. Our **Free Tundra** campaign has been picking up steam with a video that has attracted more than **60,000 views** and a petition 13,000 signatures strong. Our Free Tundra campaign continues with an additional investigation forthcoming.



SLOTH SANCTUARY

CWI was shocked to learn about the demise of the Sloth Sanctuary in an article written by two former sanctuary veterinarians and felt compelled to act. We mounted a petition that has attracted more than **72,000 signatures** and have joined a coalition of organizations that are determined to make change not solely at the Sloth Sanctuary, but in Costa Rica generally, where the situation for animals is far from idyllic.

Our investigation is ongoing and is centered around the Sloth Sanctuary, as well as Dallas World Aquarium, which has infiltrated the sanctuary.
